**ANTI-DUMPING NOTICE NO. 2018/70**

**Certain consumer pineapple**

**Exported to Australia from the Kingdom of Thailand**

**Findings in Relation to a Review of Anti-Dumping Measures**

***Notice under subsection 269ZDB(1) of the Customs Act 1901***

The Commissioner of the Anti-Dumping Commission has completed a review, which commenced on 24 November 2017, of the anti-dumping measures applying to certain consumer pineapple (the goods) exported to Australia from the Kingdom of Thailand (Thailand) by Prime Products Industry Co., Ltd.

Recommendations resulting from that review, reasons for the recommendations and material findings of fact and law in relation to the review are contained in *Anti-Dumping Commission Report No. 453 (REP 453)*.

I, ZED SESELJA, the Assistant Minister for Science, Jobs and Innovation<sup>1</sup> have considered REP 453 and have decided to accept the recommendations and reasons for the recommendations, including all the material findings of facts or law set out in REP 453.

Under subsection 269ZDB(1)(a)(i) of the *Customs Act 1901* (the Act), I declare that, for the purposes of the Act and the *Customs Tariff (Anti-Dumping) Act 1975* (Dumping Duty Act), that, the dumping duty notice currently applying to the goods exported to Australia from Thailand is to remain unaltered.

Interested parties may seek a review of this decision by lodging an application with the Anti-Dumping Review Panel ([www.adreviewpanel.gov.au](http://www.adreviewpanel.gov.au)) in accordance with the requirements in Division 9 of Part XVB of the Act, within 30 days of the publication of this notice.
