**Regarding the Disclosure of the Essential Facts for the Draft Final Determination**  
**of the Safeguard Investigation on the imports of Aluminium Foil**  
**originating in or exported from various countries**  
**18<sup>th</sup> June 2021, 10.00 a.m.**  
**Via Zoom Application**

1. The Department of Foreign Trade will not respond or answer any questions that might be raised by the interested parties during the hearing.
2. Any interested party wishing to present the evidences, views, or comments during the hearing is requested to submit the written statements by June 15<sup>th</sup> 2021, 4.30 p.m. Bangkok time. Any additional views or comments and/or information, apart from initially submitted documents, which might be raised during the hearing, shall be submitted in written form to the Department of Foreign Trade no later than June 23<sup>rd</sup> 2021, 4.30 p.m. Bangkok time.
3. The hearing will be conducted in Thai.
4. Each interested party will be allowed 15 minutes to present evidences, views or comments. The sequence of presentations will be notified by the Chairperson on the date of the hearing.
5. The representative (s) of each interested party will be allowed to present evidence, views or comments one time per person during the allotted time. The Chairperson is within his/her rights to stop any representatives who speak more than the specified time limit.
6. The Chairperson is entitled to amend any regulations that are not initially mentioned in the Rules during the hearing, whenever deemed appropriate.
